








INTERIOR COURT MAP OF SPORTS CENTER

GAMEPLAY



Rosters

- Will be confirmed with each City Director before the tournament.
- Should a team have to pull another player from another team during the tournament, it will result in a forfeit for that game (the game can still be played).

Clock

- 6th grade and younger will play 4, 7-minute quarters.
- 7th grade and older will play 4, 8-minute quarters
- Clock stops on dead balls and free throws for all teams
- Continuous clock with 20-point lead

Fouls

- 6 fouls are given to every player before they foul out
- 5th team foul and each foul after in each quarter results in 2 shots
- Fouls reset at the start of each quarter, at the start of ELAM (for 6th and above), and in OT (for 5th and below)

GAMEPLAY



Game Strategy

- Full Court Press
 - No Pressing in the 1st half for 2nd-5th Grade Teams or if up by 20 points for any age group
 - o all teams 6th & older can press at any time
- Zero zone defense. Must play man-to-man
 - An exemption to this rule is any zone presses but then must back down into a mandefense

Timeouts

• Four 30-second timeouts per game. They can be used however the coach would like throughout the game.

Overtime Rules - for 5th grade & below

- Each team is given one 30-second timeout & team fouls reset
- Play will begin with a jump ball
- 1st team to 3 points wins

GAMEPLAY



ELAM ending - How to determine the winner

- Each game's 4th quarter & ultimate winner will be determined by ELAM ending or reaching a final target score for 6th grade teams and above.
- The target score will be based on the following:
 - Actual ELAM rules
 - 5th grade and under
 - No ELAM ending the game will be played through all 4 quarters
 - 6th grade and older
 - At the first dead ball after the 5-minute mark in the fourth quarter, turn the clock off and begin Elam Ending. The team that possessed the ball will retain it.
 - Add 8 points to the lead score to get the target final score.
 - Once ELAM hits, fouls reset.
 - 3rd team foul within ELAM ending turns into 1 free throw, and the ball for the shooting team

TOURNAMENT RULES AND LOGISTICS PARENTS, PLAYERS, COACHES

Check-in

- Spectators will check in by confirming the ticket(s) purchased or by purchasing a pass the day of. You will receive a wristband for the weekend to be worn.
 - Children under 15 will not need a wristband. They are free.
 - Teams will check in as a group with your coach at the team check-in.

- After each game, players & coaches fist-bump officials, court monitors, & scorekeepers as a sign of respect & appreciation.
- Court Monitors are engaging with fans in between games and at halftime of games.

- Halftime competition for fans parents, family members, and siblings (can not be a current PSB player)
- 1st to hit a Free Throw gets a prize
- 1st to hit a 3 gets a prize
- 1st to hit a 1/2 court shot gets a prize
